Acellus Computer Lab – (entering grades 6-12) – Students may choose 1 or 2 hours in our Acellus Math Lab to work on any of the available math courses – Math’s Cool, Middle School Math 1, Middle School Math 2, FUNdamental Math, Algebra’s Cool, Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, Trigonometry, College Entrance math preparation, AP Calculus AB, AP Calculus AB Exam Prep. **Mr. and Mrs. Larabee – June 1-26 – 10:00-12:00 - \$100 - 1 hour daily for 4 weeks, \$200 - 2 hours daily for 4 weeks**

Acting – (entering grades 6-12) – Are you interested in learning the basics of acting? Then this course is for you. During these 2 weeks we will be developing your acting skills. **Mrs. Caroe - \$100 – weeks B & C – 8:30-10:30**

Ka-boom – (entering grades 6-8) – Rocketry, airplanes and explosions – We will be making and flying rockets, learning about airplanes and about explosions in this two week course. **Mr. Mouttet – \$100 – weeks B & C – 1:00-2:30**

Keep the Harvest – Home Canning 101 – (entering grade 6 – adult) – With the desire for healthy, affordable foods on the rise, home canning is a great way to provide for yourself and your family. Home canning allows you to control what goes into the food you eat. It gives you an affordable, healthy way to store foods for long periods of time. With summer harvests

and the farmer’s market, this is a perfect time of year to begin canning. We will be learning to can vegetables, make jellies, make and can soups, and taking a look at the science behind canning (why does it work?). **Mr. and Mrs. Larabee - \$200 – weeks B & C – 8:00-Noon**

High Altitude Cross Country Camp - (entering grades 8-12) – This one-week camp is for any athlete who is already in shape to learn new training techniques and methods of competing at high elevation. This is an overnight camp. Participants are required to submit a physical form and permission slip from parents for this camp. **Mrs. Cousler - \$95 (this week is subsidized by the MVCS Cross Country Team) - week A – overnight camp - \$25 discount for MVCS Cross Country Team members – cost covers transportation, lodging and some meals**

Mini Military Basic Training - (high school) – This course will offer student a brief introduction to the military, physical training, drill and ceremony, first aid, map reading, how to use a compass, a compass course, military alphabet, radio usage, and other various activities, and a visit from military recruiters to answer any further questions. **Mr. Larabee – \$150 (this course is subsidized by the US Army) - July 6-17 – 8:00-4:00**

Poetry Writing – (entering grades 6-12) – Do you like poetry? Would you like to spend a week writing poetry? We will be learning about

different types of poetry and spend time writing poetry in this one week course. **Mrs. Mouttet - \$50 – week B – 10:30-12:00**

Preparing for College – (entering grades 11-12) – During these 2 weeks, students will create an account at College Board.com and begin understanding the process involved in selecting a college, preparing an application and essay that will help them be noticed. They will learn about financial aid, honors programs, extra-curricular activities, how to create a class schedule that works, etc. Students will learn the difference between the SAT and ACT. **Mrs. Caroe - \$75 – weeks B & C – 1:30-2:30**

World War II – (entering grades 6-12) – We will be looking at the causes of the War, battles, their effects on the war and on the world then and now. We will also look at some of the technological advances. There will be a focus on the personalities of the war in this two week course. **Mr. Frisinger - \$100 – weeks B & C – 10:30-12:00**

Writing Quality Essays – (entering grades 11-12) – This 2 week writing course will prepare students for college level writing. Students will write a variety of essays in both 3rd and 1st person. Different styles will be taught. Work will be peer-edited and instructor edited. Students will learn how to appropriately cite their work, how to use the computer and research to their advantage, and how to avoid

plagiarism. Mrs. Caroe - \$100 – weeks B & C
– 10:30-12:30
